

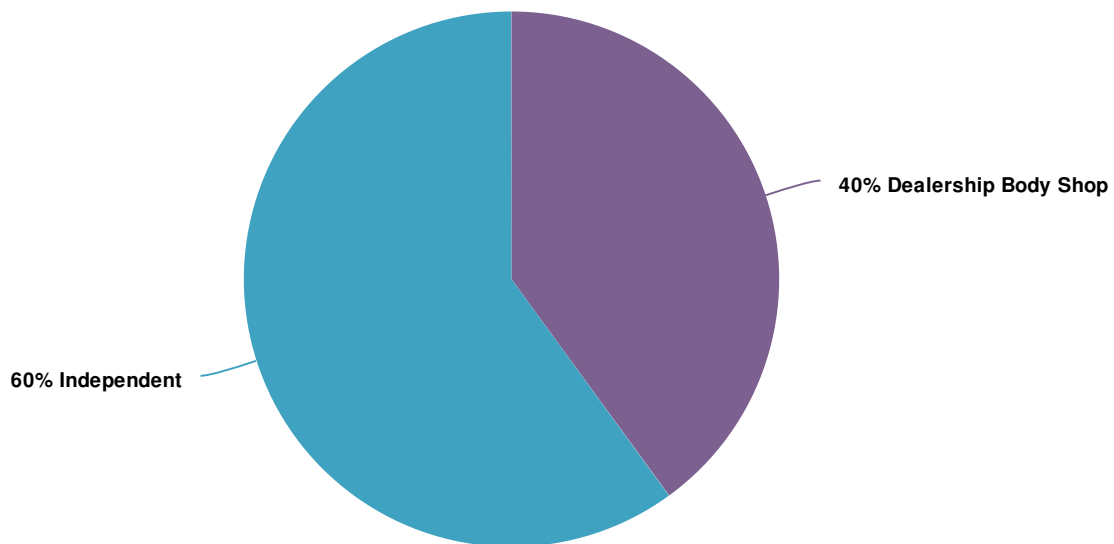

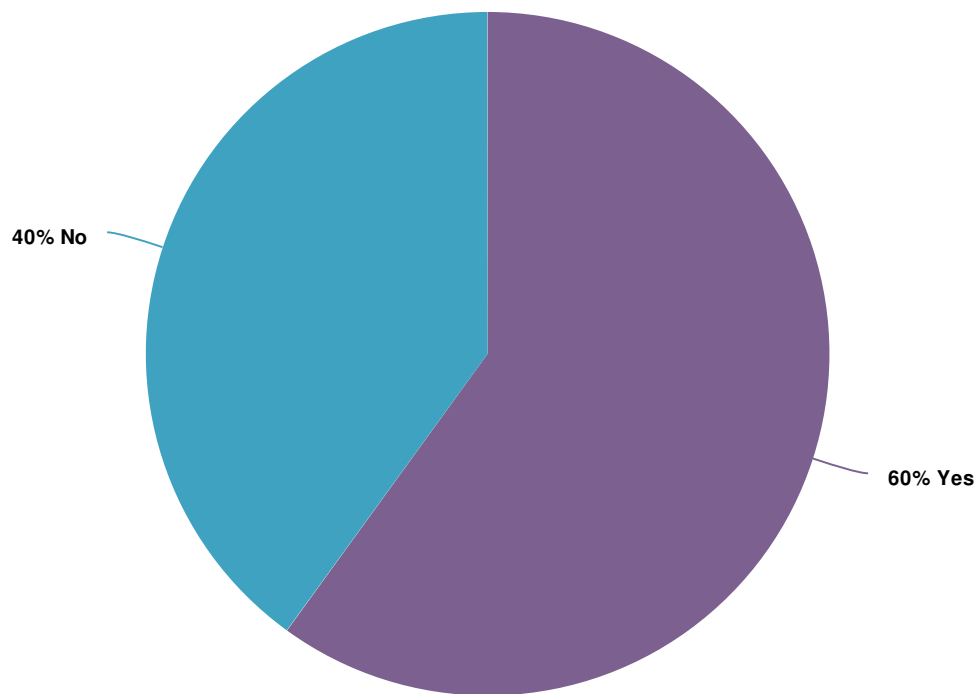
## 1. What type of facility do you have?

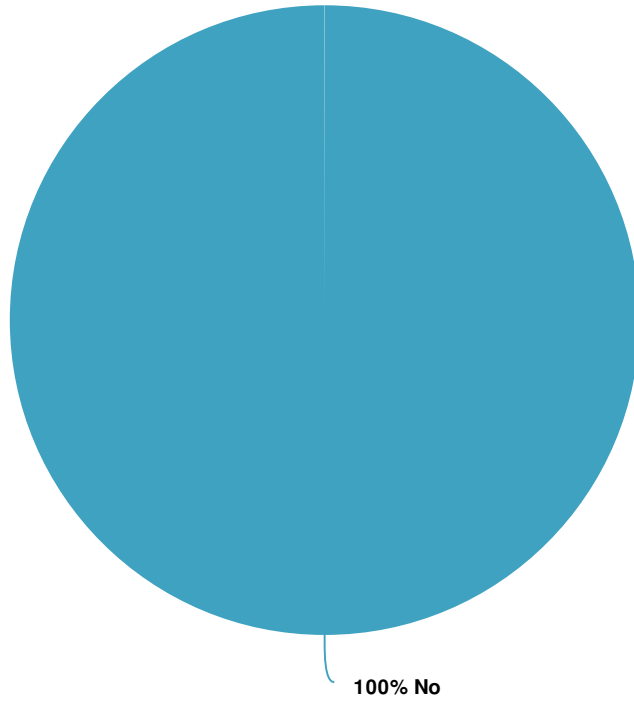
2. Do you currently employ any graduates of the NCC Collision Program?
