

Professional Attire

All employees at the NCC campus are expected to maintain a professional and neat appearance that is appropriate for the position held and the nature of work being performed. Employees having personal contact with customers, vendors, and/or the public must be particularly conscious of maintaining an appearance that presents the business image desired by the College. If an employee is participating in meetings, appointments, and/or other public or external events, they should dress in professional attire for their scheduled activity. In accordance with this policy, sleeveless dresses or shirts and knee-length dress shorts may be worn as professional attire. Stained, torn, or faded clothing or footwear, or casual attire (graphic t-shirts, sneakers, halter tops, or short shorts, etc.) shall not be permitted. Jeans will be permitted on designated "dress down" days and must be appropriate for the nature of work being performed.
