

Nashua Community College is one of the seven colleges in the Community College System of New Hampshire. Located on the Massachusetts border, NCC serves Greater Nashua and beyond. NCC offers 34 associate degree and 20 certificate programs covering careers in business, industry and transportation, health sciences and services, STEM, data analytics, social services, and liberal arts. Founded in 1970, NCC is accredited by the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE).

## How Many Students Go to NCC?

- **Enrollment** – Academic Year Fall 2023 had 1,292 students, 73% part-time and 27% full-time.
- **Running Start** – In Fall 2023, 1,110 high school students from 27 area schools enrolled in at least one of 44 courses.

## Who Goes to NCC?

- **Gender** – 54% female/45% male.
- **Age** – Average 25 years, ranging from 14 to 70 years with 66% of students under 25 years.
- **Ethnicity** – 60% are white, 21% Hispanic, 5% Asian and 6% African American.

## Where Do They Come From?

**Residence** – 94% live in New Hampshire with 74% coming from Greater Nashua.
