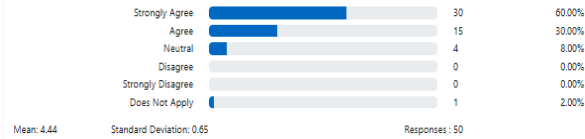
What has been most effective in helping you learn?

- The study plans during this course helped me learn a lot. They were very informational and the little quizzes in between helped me learn a lot more.

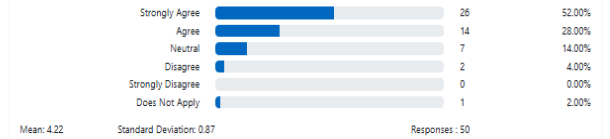

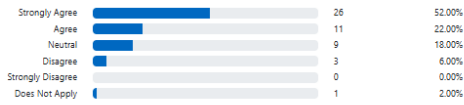

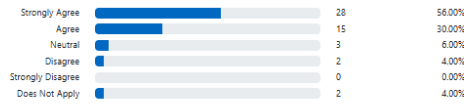

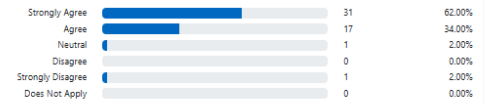

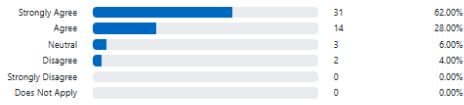

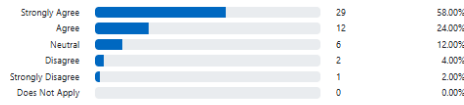

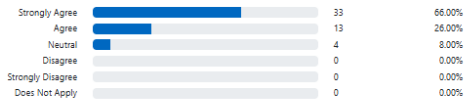

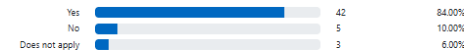

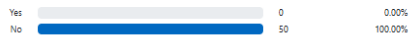
